Until when, O;Lord, you are going to permit what is happening to your people, called by your Name, to go on in the Middle East, especially in Iraq and Syria? They came to Iraq in March of 2003 and to Syria in March 2011 to free the Iraqi and Syrian people and teach them democracy. To Syria and over the past three years and nine months they sent 250,000 terrorists from 83 different countries around the world, to teach the Syrian people democracy and freedom, large numbers of them were released from prisons. The Syrian army has killed so far 100,000 of them. 50,000 went back where they came from and the country still has another 100,000 on a rampage of destruction, stealing and killing. 1,000 terrorists per month continue to enter the country illegally through the Turkish-Syrian borders. Another 100 through the Jordanian-Syrian borders, after they supply them with training, weapons, money and intelligence. So far, they have killed over 300,000 Syrians, 30,000 of those are Christians, maimed over 400,000. In addition to killing by bullets and guns, they enjoy different ways of killing, including beheading (playing football with the severed heads), crucifixion, opening the chest and eating the hearts and livers. They kidnapped thousands of people where their loved ones had no idea whether they were dead or alive. Kidnapped Bishops, Priests and Nuns. 25,000 children and women sold to Israel for \$10,000 per child and a little bit less for a woman. They sold the corpses and the wounded to harvest and sell their organs. Many women are stoned to death, thousands are kidnapped, raped and sold, most are Christians or Uazidi. The pretty ones are forced into "marriage" to the terrorists "princes" to be raped, the ones who are not so pretty are sold. In the city of Al-Rakka, Syria and the city of Mousel, Iraq, they opened "souk al-sabaya: (slave market) where the kidnapped and raped women are put on display and sold like cattle, putting 2 tags on their chests, one for a number, the second for the price which ranges anywhere from \$100 to \$500 per woman, to be raped again and again by the purchasing beasts. They burned or destroyed 100 churches and stole their invaluable ancient books and manuscripts, they looted homes and destroyed its contents, stole Syrian archeological treasurers which dates back thousands of years and sold them and still selling them to the Turks and the Europeans. They stole all the factories of Allepo, Syria's second largest city and its industrial capital, and sold it to the Turks for pennies on the dollar. They continue to steal the country's oil and sell it to the Turks for \$10.00 a barrel. They blew up and destroyed gas plants, electric generators, water reservoirs, roads bridges and medical factories. Until when O'Lord, are you going to let these atrocities continue to go on?

Never in the history of man, that half of the population of a country have become refugees in less than 2 years time, and keeps on rising, creating a humanitarian disaster of epic proportions. Half of the 22 million population of Syria have become refugees, 6 million of them outside of the country, the other 6 million displaced inside the country,

where they were forced out of their homes after it was looted, burned and destroyed, leaving all of these refugees to hunger, cold and disease. The other half of the country have very little water, electricity, gas, fuel and medicine. Half of them are jobless, inflation is rampant, and people are barely surviving.

They can stop this war of they wish, and put an end to it, but they do not want to, they do not want to stop the killing, destruction and stealing. Obviously they want no democracy, freedom or peace in the Middle East, they want to dismantle it and divide it into pieces and each one of them has his piece. They love money, other people's money (Syrian's & Iraqi's gas and oil) and the "love of money is the root of all kinds of evil", (Timothy 6:10). The killing and disappearance of Christians in the Middle East is only a collateral damage.

Persecution and killing of the Christians, especially the Middle Eastern Christians, is nothing new. It started centuries ago with the Roman Empire, the Moslems, the Mongols, the Ottoman Empire, the Turks and Communists. In the beginning of the 20th century (1910-1920) the Turks killed 2 million Christian Armenians, and 1-1/2 million of the Christian Syriac, Caldeese and Assyrians. Less than 100,000 Christians remain in Turkey these days out of 80 million Turks (0.125%) Christians made 30% of the population of Turkey in the early 1900. Between 1975 and 1990 over 100,000 Lebanese were killed and half of the Christian population left the country to Europe and the Americas. Less than 250,000 Arab Christians are remaining in Israel and Palestine combined. By the beginning of the 21st century and between 2003 and 2013, 90% of the 2 million Christian Iraqi left the country with only 200,000 remaining. In Syria, and in less than 4 years, the Christian population has dropped from 2.2 million to 1.2 million. One million have been killed, left the country or are refugees around the world. 400,000 out of 500,000 Christian Syrians have left the city of Allepo. Cities such as Homs, Malula, Sadad and Kasab are currently totally empty from its Christian inhabitants. In Homs they forced 80,000 Christians out of the city and destroyed 20 churches. In Sadad they forced its inhabitants of 15,000 Christians out and destroyed its 14 churches. In Malula they forced its 10,000 Christian inhabitants out and destroyed its 40 churches and monasteries. In Kasab they forced its 6000 Christians (mostly Armenian Syrians) out and destroyed or burned all the town's churches. So far, they have burned over 100 churches in Syria alone.

In Iraq, and on July 10 of this year, in the city of Mousel, they forced all of its 200,000 Christian Iraqi out of the city and burned most of the churches which date back to the 2nd century. One "nice neighbor" connected with the thugs, of course, gave 1200 Christian families a 24 hour notice to leave their homes and ordered them not to take anything with them except the clothes on their backs, they obliged. On August 7, 2014, they forced 150,000 Iraqi Christians out of the city of Karakoush and burned all of the town's churches.

This is a worldwide war on Christianity by Satan and his agents, the "children of disobedience". It has been going on for centuries, as I mentioned, but in these "latter years" it is not going to be limited only to the Middle East to wipe out the followers of Jesus Christ (Christians) from his birthplace (the great Syria) but to wipe them out from the entire world, while what is called the "international community" is standing by, not only watching or caring less, but aiding and helping the children of the disobedience to complete the work of their fathers.

Two thousand years ago, they rejected and conspired to kill the Holy One (Jesus Christ) and now in these "latter years" they are killing and conspiring to kill and wipe out his followers (Christians). "Why do the nations conspire and the people plot in vain? The Kings of the earth take their stand and the rulers gather together against the Lord and against his anointed one. Let us break their chains they say, and "throw off their fetters". (Psalms 2:1-3). What a pity, they do not know or deny that the Christ rose on the 3rd day after his crucifixition 2,000 years ago phrophazied by the Prophets and currently sitting on the right hand of The Father and will be returning soon to judge the dead and the living. The Prophet David continues; "The one enthroned in Heaven laughs, the Lord scoffs at them, then he rebukes them in his anger, and terrifies them in his wrath, saying, "I have installed my King on Zion, My Holy Hill". I will proclaim the decree of the Lord: He said to me, "you are my Son, today I have become your Father. Ask of Me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession, you will rule them with an iron scepter: you will dash them to pieces like pottery". Therefore, you Kings be wise, be warned, you rulers of the earth. Serve the Lord with fear and rejoice with trembling. Kiss the Son, lest he be angry and you be destroyed in your way, for his wrath can flair up in a moment. Blessed are all who take refuge in Him"". (Psalms 2:4-12).

Forgive my impatience asking you till when O'Lord? But you do know that my soul is sad, my heart is bleeding and my eyes are weeping for what is happening to my brothers and sisters in Christ in the Middle East and to all the people of the Middle East. I do know that you have forewarned that we will be persecuted for the sake of Your Name and that all men will hate us because of You. You told us that "they will hand us over to the local councils and flog us in their synagogues. On your account we will be brought before governors and kings and bear witnesses to the Jews and to the Gentiles, and all men will hate us because of You (Matthew 10:17-22). You told us "then you will be handed over to be persecuted and put to death and you will be hated by all nations because of Me. (Matthew 24:9-10). You told us that "in fact, a time is coming when anyone who kills you will think he is offering a service to God". (John 16:2) (Read also John 15:18-21, John 17:15, Luke 21:12-18, Luke 6:22-23 and Mark 13:9-13).

We Christians (the Israel of God, Gallatians 6:16) need to be awakened up with little judgment because of our sins and transgressions, the same way the Lord did to "Israel of the flesh", giving them to the hands of their enemies and into captivity (Ezekiel 39:23-28). Is it, O'Lord that you are angry with us for not loving each other, the way you loved us, and asked us to do? Or are you testing us to see whether we will remain firm in our faith and love toward You? You did tell us to stand firm to the end and we will be saved (Matthew 10:22).

Forgive me O'Lord for being impatient asking you again, "how long, Sovereign Lord, Holy and true, until you judge the inhabitants of the earth and avenge our blood"? (Revelations 6:9-10). Your answer comes that we "have to wait a little longer

PRAYER FOR SYRIA

The war continues in Syria for the fourth year. I hate to see my country in ruins. I am originally Syrian, born and raised in a Christian home in **Lattakia** on the Mediterranean Sea just about 45 miles from **Antioch** where the followers of Christ were called "Christian" first among nations. As the war worsens, attacks on Christians are becoming more common and more brazen. According to Dr. John Eibner (head of Christian Solidarity International) who recently visited Syria. Reported that Al Qaida-backed rebels were storming every little Christian town in Syria. For example, the residents who lived in the ancient Christian village of **Maalula**, where they still speak Aramaic, the language of Christ were horrified. After seizing the town, the terrorists ordered all the Christian residents to leave. While our political leaders do not want to speak about it, the reality cannot be denied. As the Archbishop of Canterbury recently said, :"It's absolutely clear that Christians in Syria are being persecuted." Dr. Eibner was able to speak to many survivors of anti-Christian terror in Syria. One man told him. We lived in an Armenian neighborhood in Aleppo, Rebels took over the neighborhood next to ours, and cut the throats of some Christians living there. I saw a man trying to throw a hand grenade at a kindergarten with forty children in it. The grenade blew up on his hand in the last second. More than 450,000 Christians have now fled their homes to Lebanon to escape war and religious cleansing and are now homeless and jobless.

Pray for Syria and for the Christians of Syria. May God inspire our political leaders to figure out a peaceful solution to this conflict, respecting the wishes of the Syrian people, who do not want their country destroyed. Our Heavenly Father, we place Syria in Your Hands. Father, I want to remind you that Paul traveled to Damascus. Father, the Gospel was preached in Damascus. Damascus, Damascus. And, Father, we pray for the canopy of the Living Blood of Jesus over the Christians in Syria. We speak to the persecuted Christians in Syria, we speak to the born again believers in Syria and we say to you, do not fear, and do not lose heart, but be strong and of good courage. The future of Syria should only be determined by the wishes of the Syrian people and not by the Islamic terrorists who infiltrated to Syria from 83 foreign countries. These are the same terrorists who attacked the WTC and killed 3000 Americans. Let us here at South Lake Presbyterian Church in Clermont, Florida pray for the Christians in Syria, the 100 churches burned by the rebels and the millions of refugees who live a miserable life in the countries neighboring Syria. In my opinion, our president and his attorney generals have turned their backs on God and on the Syrian Christians. This is shameful. The world used to look to America for moral leadership. But those days are long gone. The Bible says that one day, "all nations will be gathered before God" (Matthew 25:34) for judgment and that "at the name of Jesus every knee should bow. (Philippians 2:10). Please pray for Syria.
